Draw second pistol and engage pistol targets 3,4,4,4,4, continuing where you left off with the first pistol. Re-holster pistol.

Move to the rack and retrieve rifle and engage rifle targets 1,2,2,3,3,3,4,4,4,4 beginning on either end. Restage rifle action open.

Move to the rack and retrieve shotgun and engage four shotgun targets in any order. Target must go down to be considered a hit.

Take all guns to the unloading table.
